- Too much mechanism for implementation, but no real implementation (Researcher's Consortium, 2007)
- Qualification Framework implementation – on national level not moving fast (Researcher's Consortium, 2007)
- Focus on „new skills“ for „new positions“ (new qualifications), BUSINESSEUROPE

EHEA: Achievements, Challenges and Perspectives

- To have qualified teachers, you need to have attractive working conditions (attractiveness should be developed on European, national, institutional level (Education International))
- Hindrances to mobility/Recognition of mobility – also for staff - qualification + experience achieved are not identical to those achieved home (Council of Europe, Education International)
